Advanced Diagnostic Laboratory Tests (ADLTs) get biggest boost since Medicare pricing for new ADLTs are initially based on the test list price and because labs having proprietary tests have better control over market pricing Molecular & genetic tests generally have more favorable pricing but not uniformly so
